

Personalised Mother's Day Cushion

Tools Required:

- ScanNCut machine, standard mat and high tac support sheet
- Brother Sewing Machine
- Transfer paper
- Paper backed fusible web
- Scissors
- Size 18 cushion
- Needle and thread

Materials:

- A meaningful photo for your mum
- Calico (up to 1m) for transferring the photo
- 50cm of one fabric for cushion front
- 50cm of one fabric for cushion back
- 50cm or less for fabric frame - solid colour that co-ordinates with the other two fabrics

1. Find a photo that will have special meaning to your mum. Transfer the photo onto fabric using transfer paper (we printed our photos onto calico).
2. Choose 2 cushion fabrics that work with each other and will compliment mum's decor.
3. Following the instructions on your Brother ScanNCut, create a 'fabric frame'. The size and shape of your frame will depend on the size of your chosen photo.
4. Using paper-backed fusible web, iron the fabric frame in position over the calico with your photo, then trim.
5. Position your frame on a 50cm fabric square and pin in place. Zig zag around frame.
6. Using another 50cm square for the back and with right sides facing, pin the front to the back. Using a 1cm seam allowance, stitch around three sides leaving one side opened for the cushion insert.
7. Turn through to right side and insert a size 18 cushion. Turn under 1cm on both open edges and hand stitch the opening closed.
