## What is Mopria

The Mopria Alliance is a nonprofit membership organization formed by a group of technology companies with the goal of providing simple wireless printing from smart phones, tablets and other mobile devices. The Alliance developed the Mopria mark so users will only need to look for this designation to know that their devices are mobile print ready. Brother is an executive member of Mopria.

The main focus at the moment is Android, as Apple devices already have a simple way to print by using 'Airprint'. To keep it simple, I like to think that Mopria is the same as Airprint but for Android devices (for now).

The first supported Android operating system version for Mopria is KitKat 4.4.

Mopria will begin by downloading a plugin on the mobile device to print to Mopria compatible devices, but eventually Mopria should be built into the Android operating system on the phone or tablet.

## What you will need to print with Mopria

1. A smartphone or tablet with the Android Operating System, version 4.4 or later.
2. A printer, MFP or print accessory that is Mopriacertified.

The list of printers is growing every week; go to the supported products list to see the latest.

3. A wireless network.

The mobile device and printer must be connected to the same network.

Mopria Print Service uses mDNS to automatically discover your printer either through the local 802.11 wireless network or directly if the printer includes WiFi Direct®. The printer must be either wirelessly connected to the network router or with an Ethernet cable.

4. Apps that support Android KitKat printing.

Many native Android apps support printing, including Chrome, Gmail, Gallery, Drive and Quickoffice. Additionally, other popular apps available in the Google Play Store include the print feature. If the Print button does not display in an app, the app does not support Android KitKat (4.4) or Mopria Print Service at this time. Note: Mopria Print Service is not supported through public wireless networks such as public WiFi hotspots, Bluetooth connections, or on cellular 3G or 4G data connections.
